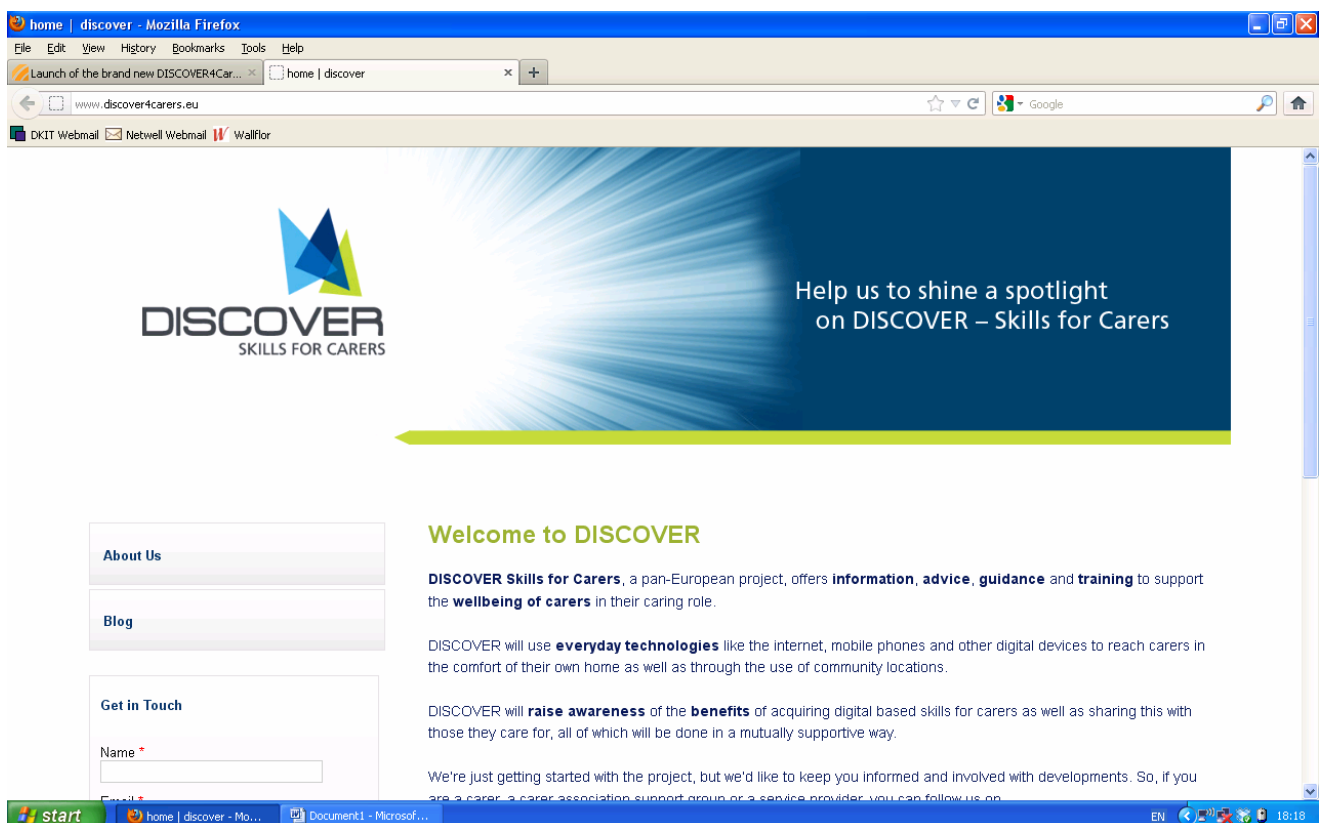

The DISCOVER Website

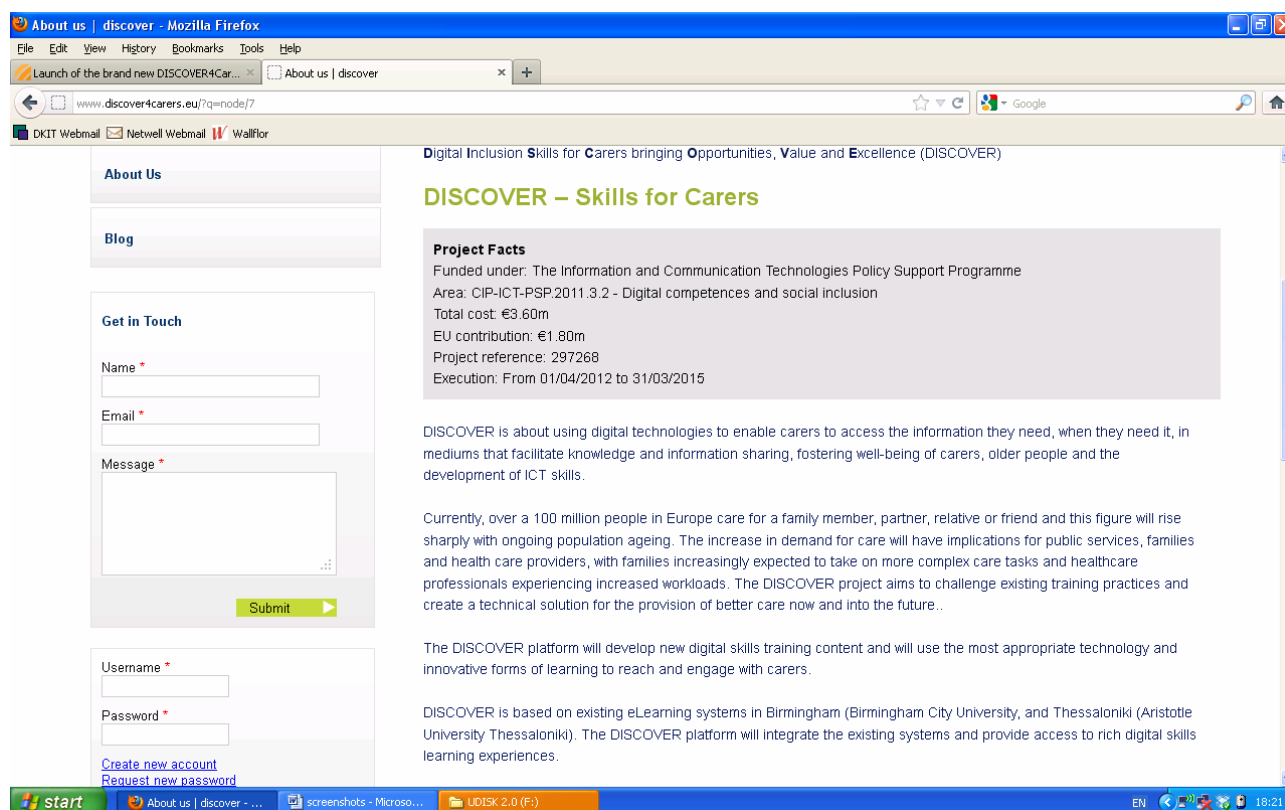
The DISCOVER project website has been created by CETEMMSA and CASALA to target carers and social health and care training providers. The website will be central for profiling project activity, relevant news, events and dissemination of key results. It will signpost to national care training providers and certification providers, providing bitesize taster content of the new courses for training providers to sample.

Current status of DISCOVER website

The DISCOVER landing page has gone live and may be accessed from the following URL: <http://www.discover4carers.eu/>. Currently the landing page provides information about DISCOVER, what it aims to achieve and how as well as the current status of the project (see the screenshot below).



A second page provides information ‘about us’, including details of the project funding programme, its budget, the partners and project rationale (see the screenshot below). The main purpose of the landing page is to enable stakeholders to sign up to project news and contact the project. Further content, including in local languages, will be built as the project develops.



Future development of DISCOVER website

As soon as the DISCOVER service is ready for deployment the website will be further refined to offer a more commercial tool to support customers with essential information. The platform will also give access (login) to the learning content for the testbed participants. The DISCOVER platform / website design will follow the same iterative and inclusive design process as for content development via user testing and feedback and ensure all technical testing, validation, accessibility and language criteria are met.

A DISCOVER blog will allow for more informal conversation from individuals involved in the project. The website will link directly to the training platform VLE (Open Source – Moodle) and e-portfolio being used by carers and other participants as part of the project. The creation of a single entry point will provide eLearning services in a multi-lingual format at Local, National, EU levels for formal and informal carers.
